Thessaloniki, GREECE



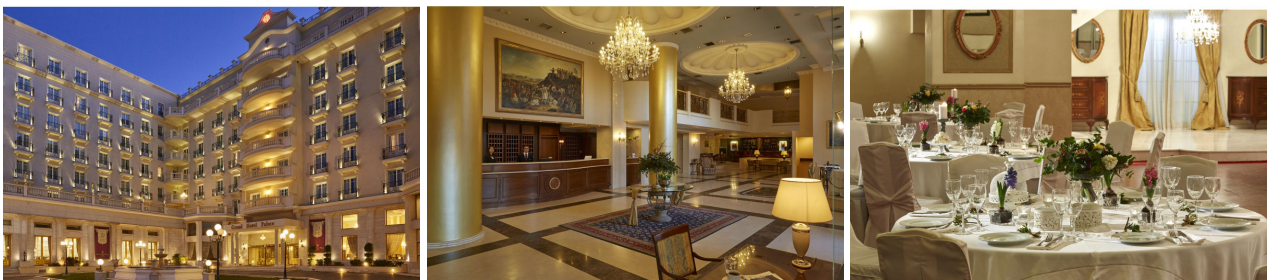
